

HOW OUR STAFF HELPS

We Care Network Case Managers screen patients for financial eligibility through the completion of a screening application and the collection of financial documents.

If a patient is eligible, the Case Manager gathers all necessary information and schedules requested services. This can include requesting medical records and working with the providers and their staff in coordinating patient care. *We Care Network* Case Managers explain to patients what to expect at their appointments. The patient does not pay for any of the care they are provided; all of the services coordinated through *We Care Network* are donated to our patients. The patient can focus on working with the specialists to improve their health and not on the cost of the care. If a patient is clinically or financially ineligible, the patient will be provided short-term case management to help identify other resources and referred back to their referring provider.

Our Mission: To Provide a Safety Net for Low-Income, Uninsured Adults Most in Need in Our Community Through Coordination of Donated Specialty Medical and Dental Healthcare



UNDERSTANDING WE CARE NETWORK

What: *We Care Network* is the flagship charitable endeavor of Capital Medical Society Foundation. It is organized to provide case management coordination to assist specialty medical physicians and dentists to donate care to low-income, uninsured adults in Leon, Gadsden, Jefferson, and Wakulla Counties.

When: *We Care Network* was started in 1992 to improve access to specialty medical services. *We Care Dental Network* was organized in 2003 to help meet the dental health needs in the community.

Why: *We Care Network* was the vision of Capital Medical Society physicians who wanted an organized and coordinated approach to provide charity care in their offices to serve low-income, uninsured adults in our community. They also wanted to make sure donated care was evenly distributed throughout the medical community and that they reduced avoidable emergency room and inpatient care.

Who: Low-income, uninsured adults whose income falls at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level may be eligible for specialty medical and/or specialty dental care through the *We Care Network*.

Who Donates: Over 300 specialty physicians, over 40 dentists, imaging centers, labs, Tallahassee Memorial HealthCare, HCA Florida Capital Hospital, surgery centers, and durable medical equipment companies donate their services and equipment to patients in the *We Care Network*.

Who Refers: Primary care providers from Leon, Gadsden, Jefferson, and Wakulla Counties refer patients to the *We Care Network*. By working with referring providers, Case Managers are able to identify patients in need of specialty medical and/or dental care and provide case management services to leverage that care.

Which Patients Qualify for the *We Care Network*?

- Adults (18 and older)
- Uninsured
- Household income and expenses at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level

For 2025:

- At or below \$31,300 yearly income for a single adult (patient)
- At or below \$42,300 yearly income for a 2-person family unit (patient, partner)
- At or below \$53,300 yearly income for a 3-person family unit (patient, partner, 1 child)
- Do not qualify for any alternative programs that could pay for the needed care

How does a patient get referred to the *We Care Network*?

- You must be referred by a medical or dental provider who identifies your need for specialty healthcare
- There are primary care centers in Leon, Gadsden, Jefferson, and Wakulla Counties that see uninsured patients on a sliding fee scale and can refer a patient to the *We Care Network*

What is donated through the *We Care Network*?

- Specialty medical and dental care that is deemed medically necessary to ensure the health of the patient
- Dental care consists of:
 - Tooth extractions
 - Root canals; crowns; and dentures
- We also provide dental care to low-income Medicare and VA patients if their insurance does not cover dental
- We help pay for prescription medications and transportation for current *We Care Network* patients

What is NOT donated through the *We Care Network*?

- Previous medical or dental bills
- Emergency Room visits
- Care that is not medically-necessary
- Care related to any legal claim, such as Worker's Compensation or a motor vehicle accident
- Dental cleanings

WE CARE NETWORK REFERRING PROVIDERS

Any primary care provider from Leon, Gadsden, Jefferson, and Wakulla Counties can refer a patient to the *We Care Network* if they identify a need for specialty medical or dental treatment.
